The civil unrest continued and things escalated, to the point that we canceled the haven retreat due to safety issues. Then GOD miraculously brought peace late night on October 13. The attendees reached out asking, "please still come!".

Then God miraculously got ALL the volunteers back on flights. Wow!... Many other ministries canceled their events, training conferences, etc., thus more workers were able to be honored at the Azmera haven retreat. To me, it was like God saying, "I want my daughters to experience my LOVE for & DELIGHT in them, in trials and in joy. My LOVE is needed now, more than training". We got to be the hands and feet of Jesus to these Kingdom-minded women who are faithfully serving Jesus in difficult places, with the hope of more coming to know Him!
