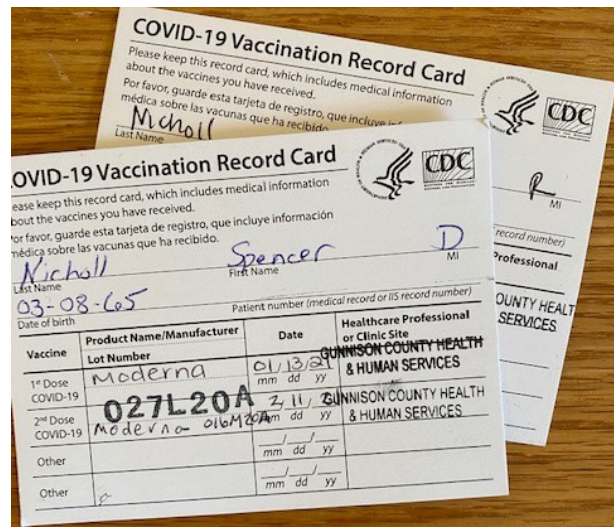
From Tanzania to Colorado
