Meanwhile, I have been working from home with folks we had planned to host. Since arriving back from Iraq in September we have hosted 4 groups. Three of these were pastors coming for a time of refreshment. And, one was helping to take Liam on his dream hunt.

Liam is 13 years old and has Cerebral Palsy. He wanted to hunt elk and with the help of a team, he was able to make that dream a reality. We had an incredible time hosting Liam and his mom.

God continues to open doors for us to minister in a wide variety of ways and places. Thank you for helping us do that!

There are several more stops on this 2021 train. In December we will hosts two more groups. The first will be a young man who is coming to hunt deer with his father. He is 15 years old and has a brain tumor. Please pray for them as we come along side a family that has been through so much and that they too will be drawn closer to the Lord.

Then we will have the opportunity to pour into another pastor who will be here for a week of respite and a “Mark 6:31” time.
