"I've gotten some desperately needed insight and time with like-minded women."

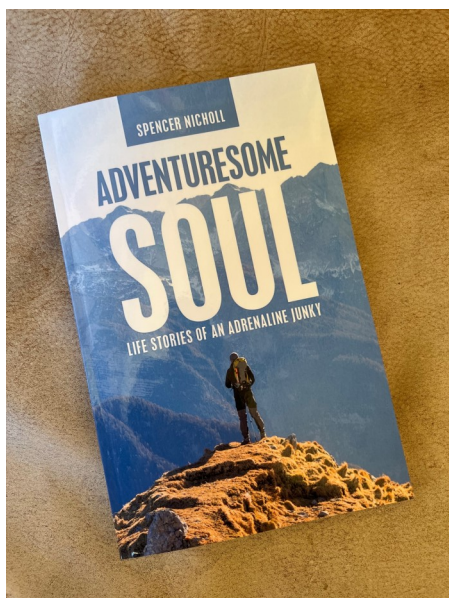
